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## **Associate Director, Rural Training Track Collaborative**

The Rural Medical Training Collaborative is excited to announce that we are hiring of a part-time Associate Director at a minimum commitment of .2 FTE up to .3 FTE.

The Rural Training Track Collaborative was founded 10 years ago to help advance best practices in rural graduate medical education (GME). Since its inception, the collaborative has evolved to focus on rural medical education training at all levels, including health professions education and medical students training in rural in addition to rural GME. This physician-specific (MD/DO) role will support leadership, advising and consulting on a number of programmatic areas including: the Annual Meeting, advising current and developing programs in rural graduate medical education best practices, supporting the Rural Program Director University for developing program leadership across the country and representing the collaborative at professional conferences such as the AAFP National Conference. In addition, this is a key role in advising the Executive Director and working with the existing staff and Board of Directors.

Required: MD/DO and experience in rural healthcare delivery

Preferred: Experience working in rural GME.

Note: This position is structured as a remote position as a time buy-out of an up to .3 FTE. Travel to professional conferences on behalf of the Collaborative is covered.
